## VE TEST SESSION

At the last VE session three people tested. We have one new technician, one upgrade to general and one upgrade to extra class.

Congratulations to:

Jeffery Pearson (KN6VTN) who obtained his technician license, Alexander Hyatt (AJ) (K6AJH) who upgraded to general, and Charles G. Lunkley (KI6HK) who upgraded to extra class.

The next VE session is scheduled for Sat. Nov 5, 2022 at 715 King Ave., Yuba City at 9:00 A.M. VE's are needed to administer the exam. The elements for Technician, General, and Extra class will be offered.

The exam requires two forms of ID. At least one of them must be a picture ID. A fee of \$15.00 is required.

A calculator may be used as long as it has had all of its memories cleared and there are no built in or preprogrammed formulas.

Upgrades to a higher class also require two forms of ID. At least one of them must be a picture ID. Also, bring your license and a photocopy of the license.

If you take an exam and pass, you can take the next higher class exam for no additional cost.

If you do not pass and wish to try again an additional fee will be required.

Please Note: You must use a FCC Federal Registration Number (FRN) to take an exam and for any transactions with the FCC. You will need this number for the forms you'll

#### complete. A FRN can be obtained at:

<u>https://www.fcc.gov/licensing-</u> <u>databases/commission-registration-</u> <u>system-fcc</u>

Also note: new licensing fees are effect. The fees will be the in responsibility of the applicant regardless of filing method and must be paid within 10 calendar days of FCC's receipt of the application. For applications filed by a VEC, the period does not begin until the application received is bv the Commission. ULS а file number assigned, and an email sent by the FCC directly to the applicant."

VECs and Volunteer Examiner (VE) teams will not collect the \$35 fee at license exam sessions. New and upgrade candidates at an exam session will continue to pay the \$15 exam session fee to the ARRL VE team as usual, and pay the new, \$35 application fee directly to the FCC by using the CORES FRN Registration system (CORES - Login).

When the FCC receives the examination information from the VEC, it will email link with payment а successful instructions to each candidate who then will have 10 calendar days from the date of the email to pay. After the fee is paid and the FCC has processed an application, examinees will receive a second email from the FCC with a link to their official license or explanation of other action. The link will be good for 30 days.
